REPRESENTATIVE PROJECTS

Naples Community Hospital

Naples, Florida
Two bridges, 50 ft and 220 ft long, (50 ft bridge is two level), connecting parking garage to medical office building to main hospital

Oriole Park at Camden Yards

Baltimore, Maryland
60 ft span open steel bridge connecting Stadium to Camden Warehouse

All Children's Hospital

St. Petersburg, Florida
150-ft glass-enclosed bridge, connecting two hospital buildings

Skyport Miami International Airport

Miami, Florida
Two 35-ft precast bridges from the Skyport (elevated helicopter terminal) to the adjacent parking garages

American Express Regional Headquarters

Miami, Florida
225-ft covered bridge connecting parking garage to office building



Cypress Creek Tri-Rail Station

Perez & Perez Architects Planners, MCM
Fort Lauderdale, Florida

This two platform station is the first of its kind in Florida, with its platforms joined by an overhead pedestrian bridge. It is designed to be the prototype for many more. Two 400 ft platforms and 75 ft long pedestrian bridge connecting the platforms on each side of the track.
